Who is Herman Wallace?

Herman Wallace has spent over 36 years in a 6'x 9' cell in Angola Prison, Louisiana. He has been in solitary confinement longer than any person recorded in US history. Herman is one of the Angola 3, along with Albert Woodfox and Robert King. The Angola 3 have survived unimaginable tragedies of injustice and torture because of their political beliefs and ability to organize from behind bars.

Who are Angola 3 Action?

Angola3Action.org is a grassroots effort designed to connect people, like yourself, who find the story of the Angola 3 appalling enough to inspire action. The objectives of Angola3Action.org are to insure the release of every member of the Angola 3. We aim to empower everyone we contact to change the current climate of injustice and racial bias in the US prison system. We are creating a coalition of people aimed towards overturning the conviction of every innocent person behind bars in the US.

After fierce legal battles and 29 years of solitary confinement for a crime he did not commit, Robert King walked out of Angola a free man in 2001.
